Dear Mr. Dillman:

The Office of the Alabama Attorney General has received your correspondence dated October 20, 2015. Your information was forwarded to the Investigative Division for review.

The main function of the Attorney General is to represent the State of Alabama and its government entities in matters affecting the State. This representation may include criminal and/or civil investigations and possible prosecutions of those matters where the primary prosecutorial authority is unable to act because of a conflict of interest.

I have reviewed your correspondence regarding your complaint concerning meetings held by the Macon County Commission ("Commission"). Your documentation shows that there is no violation of the Open Meetings Act by the Commission. It appears that proper notice was given for the meetings that were continued to different dates. Notice of the new dates was given in an open public meeting, and the meeting was not adjourned. Thus, no new notice of the continued meeting was required. Although this method of meeting may not be preferred, this Office finds no violation of the Open Meetings Act.

Your correspondence will be made a matter of record for future reference, if necessary.
